

Mobile Tennis Center Rules and Regulations

The Mobile Tennis Center strictly enforces the following rules and regulations to all players, parents, visitors, spectators, and coaches. Failure to abide by these rules and regulations may result in a ban from the tennis center. **Players assume all risks associated with play.**

Attire:

- Shirts must be worn at all times
- Sleeveless shirts are acceptable if made that way, but cutoffs are not allowed
- Clothing must be appropriate tennis attire- no cutoffs, blue jeans, bare midriffs
- Everyone must wear appropriate tennis shoes with rubber soles to enter the courts. Flip-flops, sandals, bare feet, high heels, or other inappropriate footwear is not allowed
- No offensive logos, slogans, words, or images on clothes
- No bathing suits, belly shirts, exposed midriffs, or bra tops are allowed

Conduct:

- Players assume all risks associated with play
- Players may be held liable for any damages caused due to negligence of the player
- Smoking anywhere on the premises is prohibited
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises, including the parking lots
- Loud, offensive, or foul language is not allowed at any time
- No hanging signs, moving benches, or otherwise changing the appearance of the tennis center without direct permission
- Teaching private lessons/teaching for pay/hitting for pay is strictly prohibited unless you are an authorized Mobile Tennis Center teaching professional
- All players and visitors must abide by the Inclement Weather Policy and are prohibited from playing on wet, puddled, or slick courts
- Tennis is the only activity allowed on the courts- bicycles, skateboards, skates, soccer, etc. are strictly prohibited
- Sitting, pushing, climbing, or pulling on tennis nets and fences is prohibited
- No climbing, sitting, or standing on umpire's chairs
- No animals are allowed on the courts or off leash
- Play is on a first-come, first-serve basis. If others are waiting to play, court time is limited to 1 ½ hours for singles play and 2 hours for doubles play. Mobile Tennis Center programs, tournaments, lessons, and clinics have priority over other use.

Payment:

- Payments for courts, lessons, and clinics are to be made in full prior to going to the court
- "Bulk Payments" for lessons are an arrangement between the student and the pro and need to be worked out with the pro in advance
